- Promote the emergence of innovative real estate products and set ups.

- Carry out a market research strategy with companies and investors.
- Provide suitable premises and spaces for the needs of companies of all sizes, in particular productive, innovative or socially oriented enterprises.
- Support business development across the territory and the relocation of those affected by development projects.
- Contribute to marketing real estate products.


